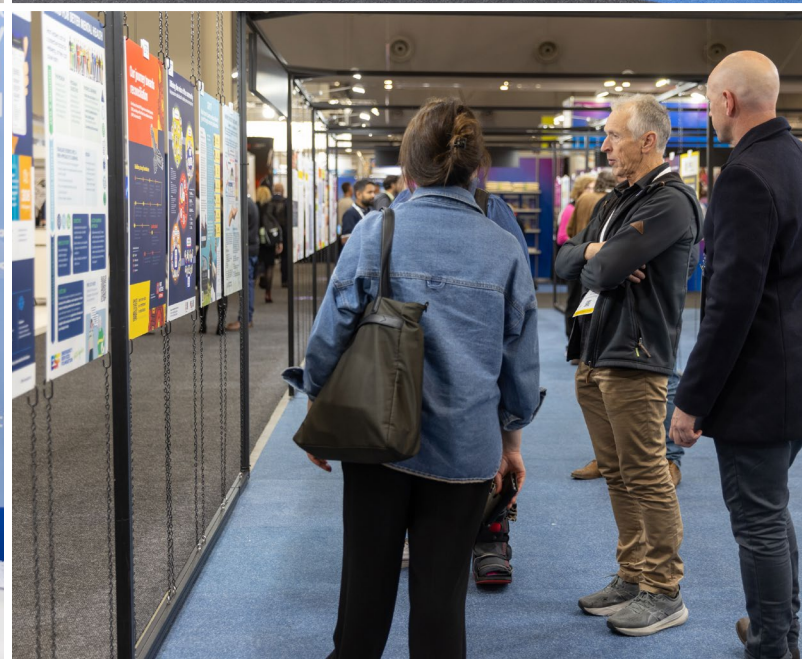
# About the conference

The Australian Disaster Resilience Conference (ADRC) is Australia's premier disaster risk reduction and resilience conference. ADRC is a destination for delegates seeking knowledge, research, and community-based case studies, as well as opportunities to network and collaborate. This conference, now in its tenth year, is the largest and most impactful event of its kind in the southern hemisphere and attracts delegates from across the globe.

The ninth Australian Disaster Resilience Conference (ADRC25) was held on 27–28 August 2025 at the Perth Convention and Exhibition Centre.

ADRC25 ran alongside the AFAC25 powered by INTERSCHUTZ Conference and Exhibition, Institute for Fire Engineers (IFE) Conference, and Women and Firefighting Australasia (WAFAs) Conference. Together, the conferences and exhibition attracted approximately 4451 delegates.

ADRC26 will be held at the Melbourne Conference and Exhibition Centre in August 2026.

## Reach

An increasing number of attendees are from local and state government and not-for-profit organisations, as well as health sector representatives, universities and emergency services staff.

Most attendees are from Australia but international delegates are increasing.

Delegates reported that they heard about ADRC25 through the Australian Institute of Disaster Resilience's (AIDR) monthly newsletters, direct emails, social media posts and the website. AIDR's communications reach a stakeholder network of approximately 14,000 contacts.

An increasing number of delegates are returning each year, citing ADRC as a 'must attend' disaster risk reduction event on their calendars and a key opportunity to learn, network, and collaborate with like-minded individuals.

ADRC delegates highly rate the conference (84% said 'excellent' or 'very good') and describe it as well organised (93% said 'excellent' or 'very good').

94% of ADRC delegates would recommend the conference to their colleagues and contacts.
