Access to NAB's Volunteering and Giving Program

Be part of NAB Neighbourhood

NAB colleagues can quickly and easily take part in volunteering and giving opportunities with organisations like yours via NAB Neighbourhood, our technology platform powered by **Benevity**.

By signing onto your organisation can:

- Access 30,000+ NAB colleagues nationally, who have a minimum of two days general volunteer leave each year and unlimited skilled volunteer leave.
- Find volunteers to work with you face-to-face or virtually, for either short or long-term projects.
- Connect with skilled volunteers to help you with a huge variety of tasks, such as data analytics, strategy, marketing, or solve strategic problems.
- Advertise your fundraising campaigns to NAB colleagues through internal channels.
- Have the opportunity to be part of matched fundraising campaigns.
- Receive colleague donations, including one-off or recurring pre-tax workplace giving.



How to **sign up** NAB Neighbourhood

To be eligible for NAB Neighbourhood, you need to:

- be registered with the Australian Charities and Not-For-Profit Commission;
- hold DGR1 status;
- complete Benevity's self-certification questions;
- register for EFT payments through Benevity.

To advertise volunteering opportunities and receive workplace giving donations*, NAB Community Volunteering Standard Terms will also need to be signed.

* Please note, if you are ineligible to create a cause profile on Benevity to receive workplace donations, we can still support your cause with volunteers. Ask as at **NABNeighbourhood@nab.com.au**
