Helping safeguard communities with grants of up to \$10,000 for projects that make Australia more prepared for natural disasters and support long-term recovery.

ABOUT THE GRANTS

- Up to \$10,000 will be awarded to initiatives that prepare people, homes, business, towns, cities and our environment for natural disasters, and support long-term recovery and resilience work.
- This could take the form of education, training, emergency systems, preparedness plans, mental health, infrastructure and climate risks.
- Previous recipients include soil regeneration projects, a local film festival and native bee habitats.
- Funding will go where locals tell us it's needed
- Charities or organisations with charitable purposes can apply, including sporting clubs, chambers of commerce and schools.
- NAB Foundation gives up to \$1 million in total each year in community grants.

OUR AIMS

- ✓ **Readiness:** help communities (people, environments, infrastructure) prepare for natural disasters.
- ✓ **Recovery:** help communities, landscapes and fauna rebuild and rehabilitate after natural disasters.
- ✓ **Future-proofing:** reduce the risk of future natural disasters by cutting a community's carbon emissions.

HOW TO TELL YOUR COMMUNITY

Share the application form with your local community: charities, chambers of commerce, clubs, community hubs and emergency services.
